

***Wisconsin Precast Concrete Association  
Scholarship Application Conditions***

1. This scholarship is established to reward students planning to obtain a higher education. It is supported by income generated by association members' contributions.
2. Applications must be received or postmarked **no later than December 1, 2008** (scholarships are awarded for the 2009-2010 school year). No exceptions will be made.
3. Applicants must be the immediate family (spouse, child) of:
  - A. A member or associate member in good standing of the Wisconsin Precast Concrete Association.
  - B. An employee of a WPCA member company.
  - C. WPCA members and their employees are also eligible.
4. Scholarships will be awarded at the Winter Convention Banquet in January 2009. WPCA will notify the recipients in writing immediately and issue a check in the amount of the award in August of the year awarded. The winner of the scholarship, a family member of the winner or a representative of the company sponsoring the winner is expected to be present at the 2008 WPCA Winter Convention so that they can be recognized for their accomplishments.
5. No person may receive more than one award in his or her lifetime. (This provision can be reviewed and overturned by the scholarship committee on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the committee.)
6. Applicant must be a member of the senior high school class or graduate of a secondary school, including those who are older than high school aged desiring to continue their education. This award is also available to past or current college students.
7. Instructions for applying for a WPCA scholarship:
  - A. Fill out the application form completely. Use extra paper if necessary.
  - B. Send to WPCA, Scholarship Council, 16 N. Carroll Street, Suite 900, Madison WI 53703, with the following:
    1. Scholarship Application Form
    2. Essay approximately 500 words in length.
    3. Reference letters from two persons unrelated to the applicant (teachers, employers, coaches, clergy, etc.) who can attest to the applicant's character and assess academic ability.
8. The number of \$500 scholarships awarded will depend on the amount of contributions made to the scholarship fund. (These amounts may be increased at the discretion of the WPCA Scholarship Committee.)

***Scholarship Selection Procedure***

1. The applications are forwarded to the selection committee composed of qualified scholarship judges not affiliated with WPCA or any of the applicants – Wisconsin high school teachers or guidance counselors from differing areas of the state each year.
2. The scholarship judges will rank the applications. The number of \$500 scholarships awarded will depend on the amount of money in the scholarship fund each year.
3. The winners will be announced during the WPCA Winter Convention in January.
4. All non-winning applications will be returned to the applicants at their request.
